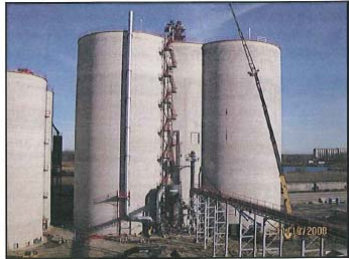

TANK FARM

To the left are two 1.5 million gallon storage tanks, 190 and 200 proof process tanks, a denaturant tank, and a vessel storing corrosion inhibitor. Pipe racks and piping are being installed.



CORN SILOS

The conveyor which transports the ground corn to the slurry tanks is being constructed. The silos hold 500,000 bushels each.



HAMMERMILLS

To the left are the four hammermills used to grind more than 100,000 bushels of corn per day.

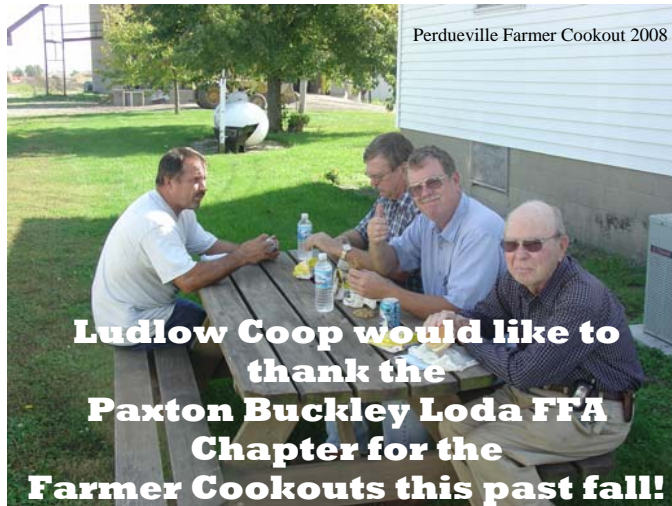


GRAINS RECEIVING & LOADING

There are two bays with pits for unloading corn trucks, and two rail bays. One rail bay will be used to unload corn, and the other for loading DDGS.
